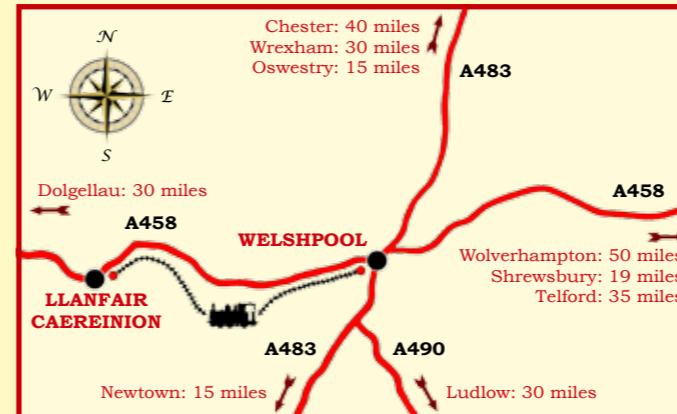

# THE WELSHPOOL & LLANFAIR RAILWAY

The Welshpool and Llanfair Light Railway was built to link farming communities with the market town of Welshpool and provide them with an outlet for their produce. Operated at first by the Cambrian Railways the line was taken over by the Great Western and then British Railways.



After 1931 the railway only carried freight traffic and was finally closed in 1956; but that was not the end. In 1963 a group of enthusiasts rallied round and began to progressively re-open the line until it became the railway you see today.

The original builders of the W&L chose a gauge of 2ft 6ins to allow for tight curves and steep gradients so that the railway could traverse the rolling landscape of this attractive part of Mid Wales.

The journey on today's W&L begins on the edge of Welshpool and carries the traveller up the notoriously steep Gofa Bank and into the delightful Banwy Valley.

The train passes through a charming rural patchwork and winds its way along the river Banwy into Llanfair Caereinion.

The open balconied carriages provide the traveller with a unique view on this scenic journey through a truly idyllic landscape.

### Llanfair Tea Room & Shop



While you are at Llanfair Caereinion don't forget to visit the excellent station café which serves freshly made food, hot and cold drinks plus ice creams.
